

Why Focus on Full Transfer Drills?

The 3 Delays Framework

In community-integrated maternity care models, **preventable** morbidity and mortality are often related to one or more **delays**.

1. Recognizing a problem and seeking a higher level of care

2. Reaching the appropriate level of care

3. Receivingcare after
reaching
facility



Reframing the "Train Wreck"

Hospital personnel may fear integration with community birth services due to fear of a "train wreck" transfer.

What we do after an actual train wreck:



Gather information from all available sources



Analyze data to determine root cause



Report publicly on findings and any recommendations for change



Support survivors and family of those harmed




Advocate for change



What we don't do after a train wreck:

- **♦** Lobby against all train travel
- ◆ Automatically blame the conductor
- ◆Shame passengers for choosing the train as a mode of transportation

Debriefing Questions

What happened?

Give just a brief, high-level summary so everyone's on the same page.

What went well?

Give everyone a chance to share the good stuff they noticed before critiquing.

What needs attention or improvement?

Try to focus on processes and systems, not assigning blame.

What should we do differently going forward?

Make sure to assign someone to follow through on the change.

Action Steps

- What changes are needed to process or procedures?
- How should this emergency be documented in the medical record?
- What other reporting is required for this emergency transfer?
- What other follow up would be expected after this emergency?
