

Advanced Practice Provider Residency Training Program

at Yakima Neighborhood Health Services

The APP Residency class begins September 2025.

This 12-month program, in Washington, will provide intensive training on both the clinical complexity of family practice in the safety net setting and on a high-performance, PCMH model for primary care. The program is specifically intended for new Family Nurse Practitioners and Physician Associates/Assistants who are committed to practice careers as Primary Care Providers in the challenging setting of rural community health centers and other safety net settings. The program structure includes precepted primary care sessions, specialty rotations, mentored independent clinics, didactic sessions and quality improvement.

QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants must be recent graduates (within 24 months) of a Masters, DNP, or PA program, and certified or board eligible as an FNP or PA and licensed in WA, with a stated commitment to practice as a primary care provider in a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) or other safety net setting. The residency is a full-time, 12-month salaried position with benefits.
